## **Celebration Sunday!**


#### Sunday, May 7



## **Book Review:** How the Word is Passed

I read this book with the RAF group this fall, as it was being read as the Go Big Read book at the University of Wisconsin. It is a very interesting and readable book which turns much of the history of slavery as we know it on its head.

Smith focusses on places and how their history has been portrayed over the years, along with his own travels, interviews, and observations of how this portrayal fits with Black history and the history of slavery.

## **Reach Dane Sneaker Drive**

The Mission Committee is sponsoring a Sneaker Drive at Covenant during the month of May to benefit children in **Reach Dane** programs. Reach Dane, formerly known as Head Start, serves children and families in Dane County through education and supportive services. The number of infants and toddlers enrolled in their programs who are experiencing homelessness has tripled over the last four years. Currently, 32% of the children in their programs are homeless.



You can help by donating the following items! Please drop off in the gathering space by May 28:

Sizes needed are those to fit children from ages 2-5. (Toddler 2T-10T and Little Kid 11-13). Financial donations are also welcome and will be used to purchase the most needed sizes. The regularly-scheduled Session meeting took place virtually on April 25. It has been decided that the meeting will alternate between in-person and virtual meetings for the remainder of the year. The focus of the meeting was to discuss the book "Real Good Church" by Rev. Molly Phinney Baskette. The group talked about the "ten reasons you should go to church." The consensus was that Covenant is doing much of what the book recommends.

In church business news, the Finance Committee brought a Fixed Asset Policy forward which was approved. Their current focus is to get as many policies developed and approved as possible during the summer to satisfy many of the finance review recommendations. The Personnel Committee brought news that when Pastor Clara retires (again) on May 28, Donna Monson will return on a part-time basis to do pastoral care. She will be at church every other Sunday and stay on until one week after the new Associate Pastor starts. Finally, the next Presbytery meeting is on May 16 and Covenant will send two representatives to participate at the Union Presbyterian Church in Monroe, WI.

# **Mission Spotlight**



One of the four special offerings of the PC(USA), the Pentecost Offering, is a church-wide effort to support and inspire young people. Local congregations are allowed to retain 40% of the total amount collected to be directed to local agencies that support children and youth. This year, Covenant's Mission Committee has chosen **Free Bikes 4 Kidz Madison** to be the beneficiary of our portion of the Pentecost Offering, which will be collected on Pentecost Sunday (May 28).



Adventure! Freedom! Do you remember the joy of pedaling off on your own first bike? Each year, Free Bikes 4 Kids Madison collects thousands of donated bicycles and refurbishes them to give away to marginalized communities in Dane County, Racine and Milwaukee. As an added bonus, they keep thousands of bikes out of landfills by repurposing them into rideable bikes.

Since 2017 Free Bikes 4 Kids Madison has given away over 8,200 bikes to young people. Bikes are distributed through schools and other nonprofits. Covenant's mission partners The Boys & Girls Club of Dane County, Lussier Community Education Center, RISE Wisconsin and JustDane are among over 100 organizations who have received free bikes from FB4K.

In addition to financial support, FB4K accepts donations of used bikes. They are also looking for volunteers to help refurbish bikes and help with distribution. For more information or to volunteer, visit their website at fb4kmadison.org.
